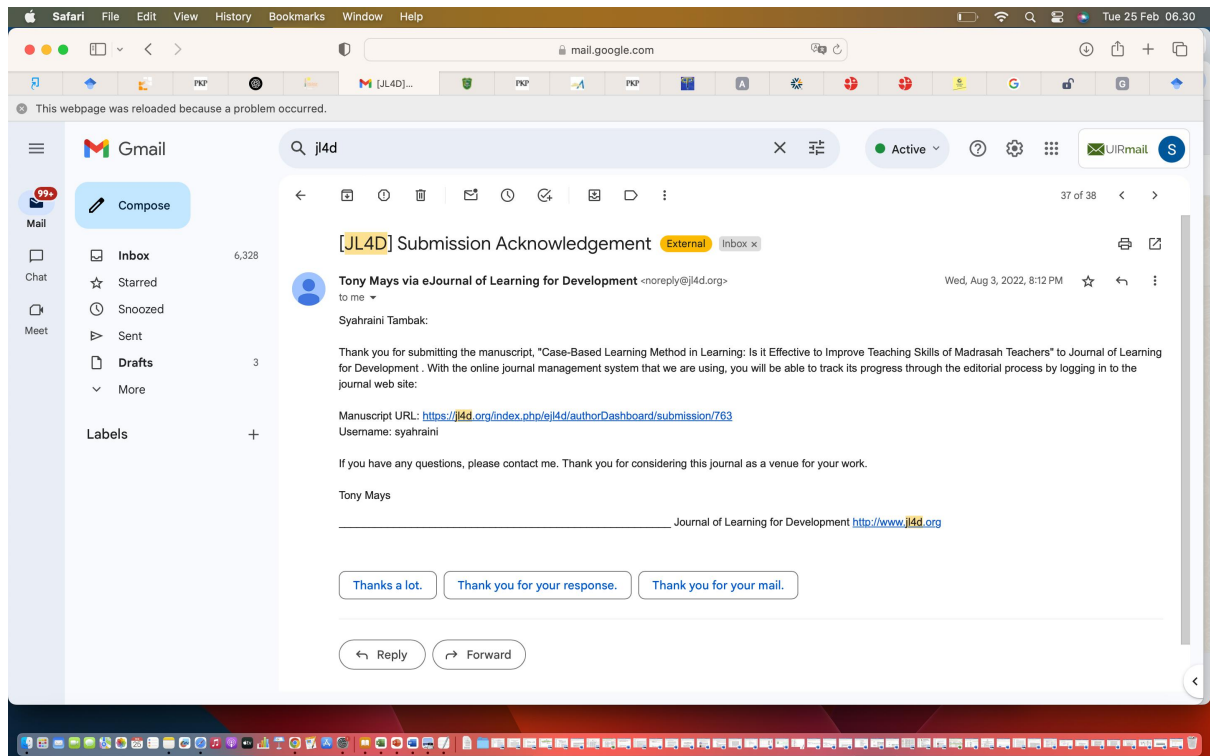
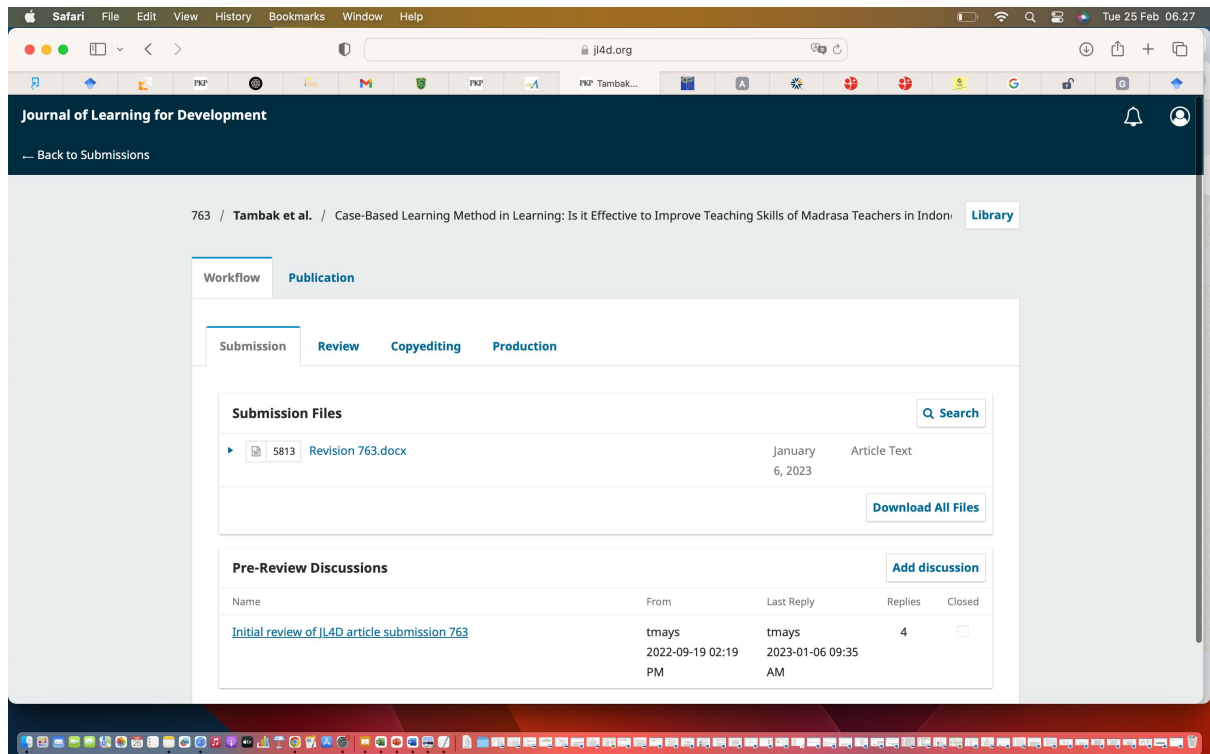

Thank you for your submission to JL4D.

Before we send it for external review, we request a few changes as follows:

1. The 'Introduction' section needs to have a sub-section on 'Conceptual/ Theoretical Framework of the Study' and another on 'Research Objectives/Questions'.

Note

2. The Methodology section should be retitled as 'Methods', and be divided clearly into the following sub-heads: i) Research methodology, ii) Sample and sampling method, iii) Instruments including their reliability and validity, and iv) Procedure of data collection. Moreover, this section is too lengthy with 2092 words, and this should be reduced to less than 1000 words.

3. The 'Results' section should be presented research question/objective-wise.

4. The overall length of the paper may also be reduced (this will happen once the length of the 'Methods' section is reduced).

Please share a revised version of your paper at your earliest convenience.

Also, please consider that most readers of the journal are involved in some form of ODeL provision. What are the implications of your research for teachers involved in distance, blended or online learning?

Finally, at 9,000 words, the paper is now too long. It needs to be trimmed back to 6,000 words inclusive of references.

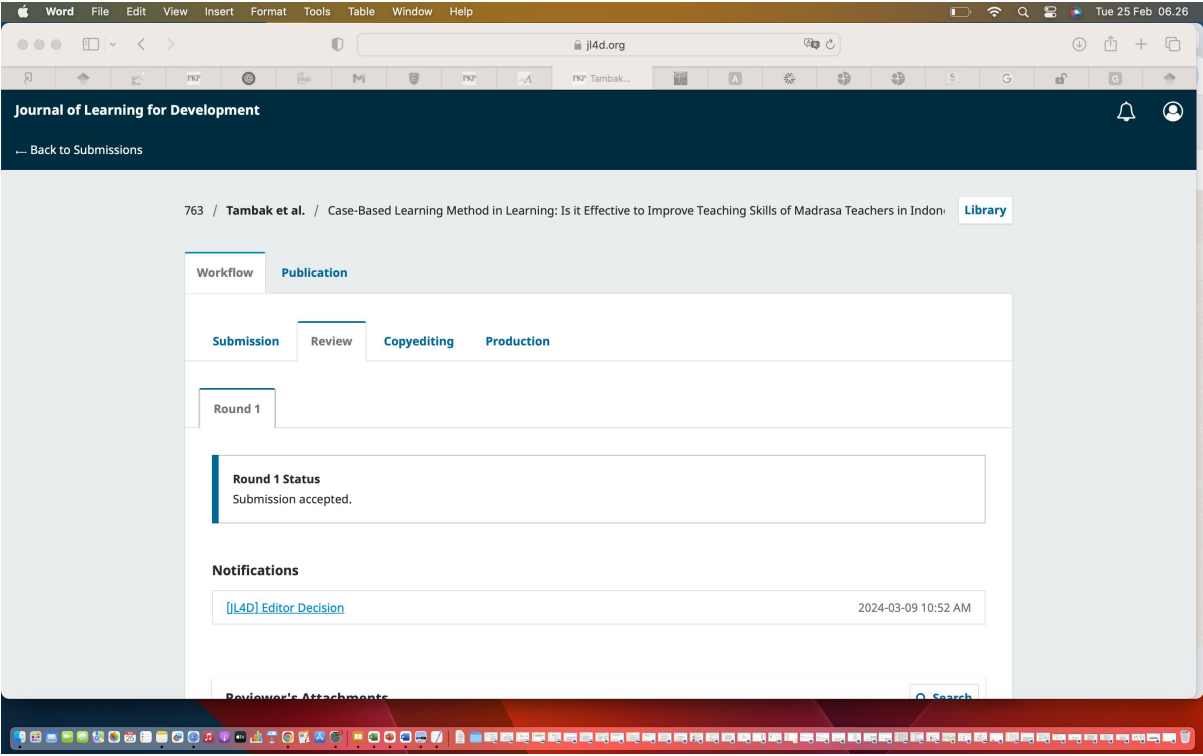

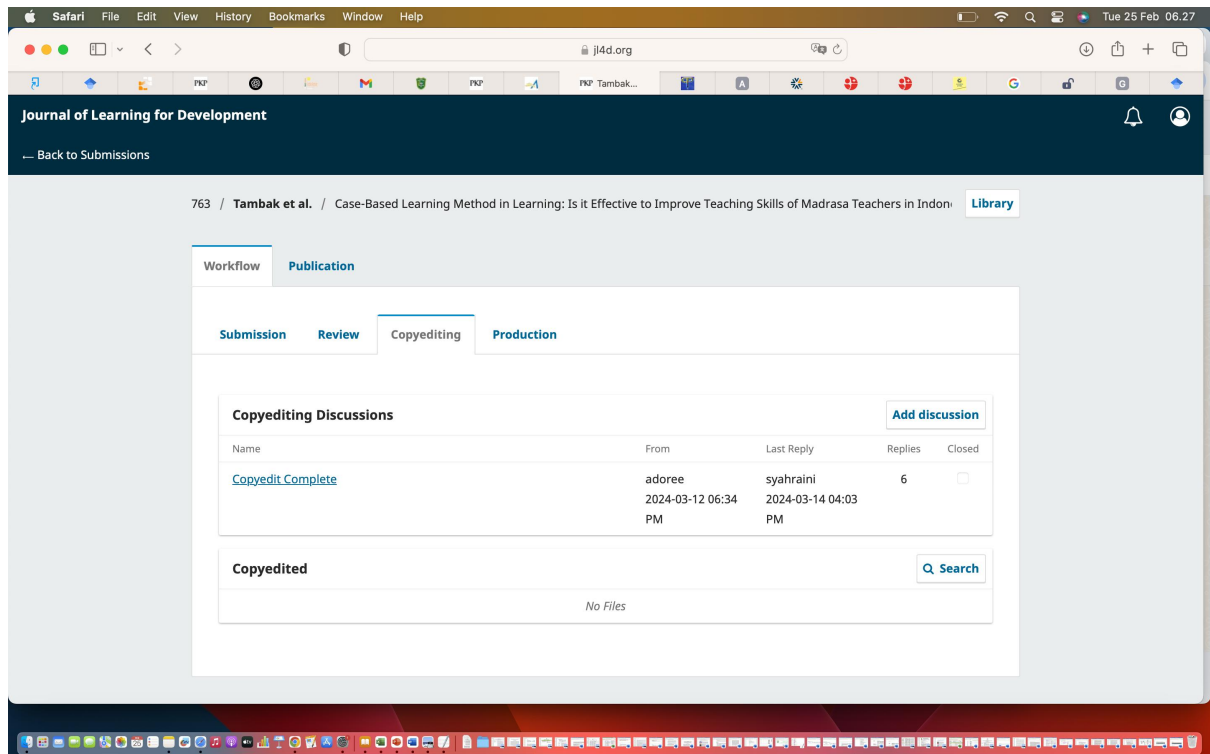
