CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

3.1. Research Design

The design of this research was qualitative approach. Qualitative research is kind of research concerning with acquiring data in the field which does not need to use the number (Statistical Analysis), Seno (2001).

Moreover, Borg and Gall (1998) that cited by Sugiyono, Qualitative research is much more difficult to do well than quantitative research because the data collected are usually subjective and the main measurement tool for collecting data is the investigator himself.

Telephoning Conversations were the source of data in this research. The writer has listened the telephoning conversation and wrote all utterances and drawed into the table according the preferred and dispreferred second.

3.2. Location and Time of the Research

The research has done at English Study Program of Islamic University of Riau. The research has been conducted at 1st of January until 28th of February 2017.

3.3. The Population of the Research

The population of the research are the students of English Study Program of The Teacher's Training and Education Faculty of Islamic University of Riau.

3.4. The Sample of the Research

The samples of the research are 20 students or about 10 pairs of 5th Semester of English Study Program of The Teacher's Training and Education Faculty of Islamic University of Riau in 2016. The writer has taken the data from telephone conversation in the environment of English Department by random sampling.

3.5. The Instrument of the Research

The instruments of this research are:

- 1. Telephone/Handphone
- 2. Voice Recorder

According to Levinson (1983: 336) provides examples of adjacency pairs as found in English.
