#### **CHAPTER III**

### RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

## 3.1. Research Design

The research method used to analyze this problem was qualitative method that describes and qualifies the imlpicature and translation method which were used in *Hangover* film. According to Bogdan and Taylor (1975) qualitative research is designed to reveal a target audience's range of behavior and the perceptions that drive it with reference to specific topics or issues.
