#### **CHAPTER III**

#### RESEARCH METHOD

### 3.1 Research Design

The research method is an essential part of conducting a research. The method used in this study is qualitative. Design of the research used qualitative it means in qualitative research have description quality and disposed of used analysis with qualitative approached.

Herdiansyah state that qualitative research is a research that produces descriptive data in written and spoken by people that we observe their behavior (as cited in Rugaiyah, 2016: 2)

So, the writer presents the data collected in words than numbers. Furthermore, this research is designed in a case of study and she only examines single subjects like Bogdan and Biklen (2007: 5) state that a case study is a detailed examination of one setting or a single subject.

#### 3.2 Source of Data

Data is information about something that needs to be analyzed. Source of data in this research is an open questionnaire that is given to two Junior High Schools at Pekanbaru. They are SMP Negeri 4 Pekanbaru and SMP Negeri 5. The researcher chooses the two schools because they have A accreditation in National Accreditation Institution of School/ Madrasah (BAN-S/M). So, they can represent all of Junior High Schools in Pekanbaru. Then, those schools have Literacy Program. This study will use purposive sampling as a tool for informant selection,

According to (Patton,1990; 169) the standard that use to choose the participant is they are that know well about the information.

The questionnaire is an open questionnaire that written in bilingual (English and Indonesia) and viewed the five categorize indicates reading habit. The indicators are:
