In the reading habits, there were some features which used by the reader in reading activity. This research was descriptive qualitative. The researcher has chosen the vocational schools as the object. There are 56 students of three vocational schools around Marpoyan Sub-district. Then, the data obtained were analyzed based on J. Caesar's concept which consists of Attitude Towards Reading, Book Read, Frequency Reading, Time Spent on Reading Habit, and Motivation on Reading Habit.

Based on the data interpretation, there were 54 questions in the questionnaire. Then, there were 56 samples of three vocational schools especially accounting major at the first grade of each school.
