

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

3.1 Research Design

The research was conducted to know the barriers of the implementation of English language students in implementing practical teaching is qualitative research, The researcher used case study design.

Herdiansyah state that qualitative research is a research that produce descriptive data in written and speech from people that we observe their behavior (as cited in Rugaiyah, 2016: 2)

A case study is an in-depth exploration of a bounded system (e.g., activity, event, process, or individuals) based on extensive data collection(Creswell,2007). This reserach is intended to analyze the barriers of pre-service teachers at FKIP UIR in practical teaching.

3.2 Source of Data

This research held at FKIP UIR Pekanbaru. The population of the reserach were all of English students which have passed micro teaching subject and that were pre-service in practical teaching. There were 100 population of the eighth semester of English Language Education which consist of six classes. According to Arikunto (2008:116) *“Penentuan pengambilan Sample apabila kurang dari 100 lebih baik diambil semua hingga penelitiannya merupakan penelitian populasi. Jika jumlah subjeknya besar dapat diambil antara 10-15% atau 20-55%*

atau lebih. Because the population 100 then researchers take samples 25% of the population. The indicators of this research will be provided on the table 3.1.

3.3 Data Collection Technique

In conducting this research, the data were collected by given questionnaire to the sample. The procedures to conduct the data were as the following: 1) the researcher gives 25 questionnaire, 2) the researcher to follow the sample to answer the questionnaire, 3) the researcher analyzed the students answer based on indicator, 3) the researcher interview some of students to compare and support the data.

In other words, proper techniques and data collectors in a study will be able Enabling the achievement of valid and reliable problem solving, which in turn will enable the formulation of objective generalizes (Nawawi, 1995: 94). The data required in this study were collected using: 1) interview technique, 2) questionnaire technique.

3.3.1 Interview

According to Lexy (2014) interview is a conversation with purpose. Usually an interview is done by a person interviewer or more who will be the interviewees.

3.3.2 Questionnaire

According to Arikunto (2013:194) questioner are numbers of written questions that are used to obtain information from respondents in the sense of reports about his personality or things knows.

3.4 Data Analysis Technique

This research is intended to find out the barriers of pre-service teachers at FKIP UIR in practical teaching. the first step was to analyze the thirty student's answer questionnaire. The researcher read and classified the students answer based on indicators of the barriers in practical teaching students answers yes or no, students also mention their opinion on each question and interview give. After all the students answered has classify, the researcher shown result of students answered in data description and data analysis on chapter four. The data through questionnaire the researcher had interview some of the students, the researcher had analyze the data and describe what are the barriers in practical teaching.
